# WASTE AUDIT DAY 🌍

As part of our What's for Lunch topic Whare Aroha with the support of Koka Kauri from Enviro Schools spent all of Tuesday sorting through and classifying the rubbish that we threw into our bins on Monday. This was a very interesting activity and brought out some results that we need to look at. From the Audit, we learnt that we waste a lot of paper by not using both sides. The students collected over 500 empty chip packets which all together filled up one 240 litre wheely bin. Three students threw away 3 full snack size bags of chips on Monday, one class threw away a full bottle of glue. Someone threw away a can of fly spray that still had spray left in it and we threw more compost food scraps into the rubbish bins than we did into the compost bins. These are just some of the findings from the waste audit. We will share more results with you in future panui.
