Maths Buddy ...

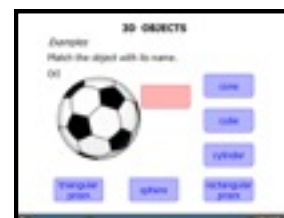
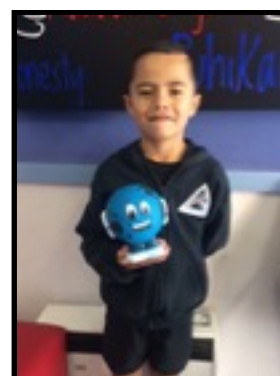
