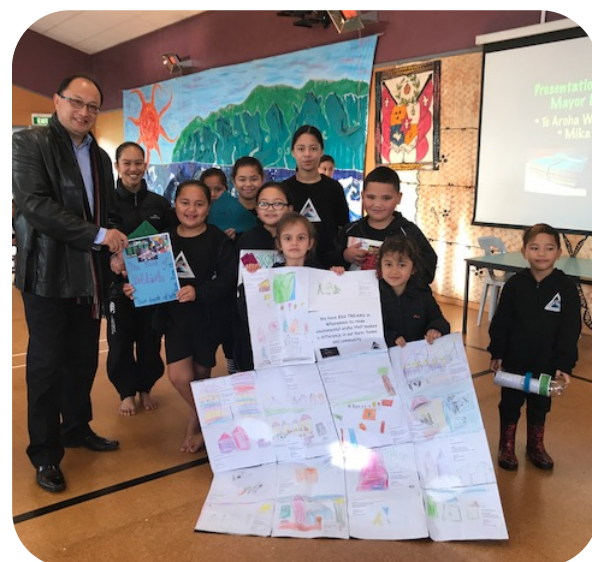
Kia ora Whānau,
