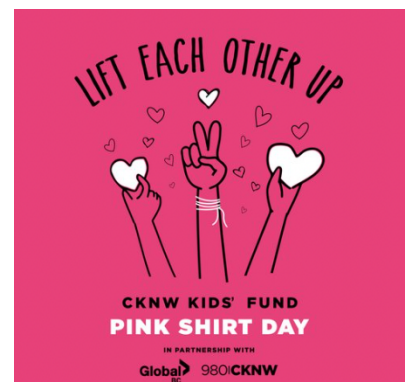
BANKING
