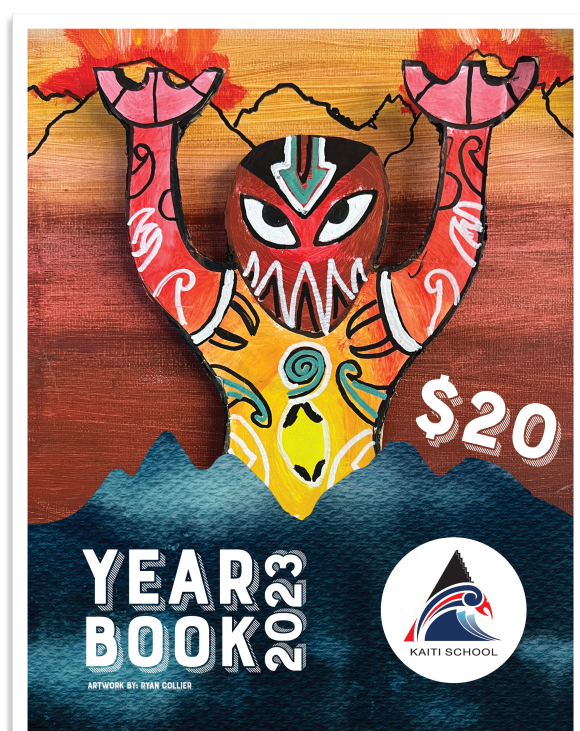
KUTUS
