Enrolment to Year 7 Tū Rangatira

Tū Rangatira is a Māori Medium (Level 2) learning pathway. The class can cater for 22 Year 7 students and 22 Year 8 students. Because of limited spaces and huge interest from whanau, there is a criteria for entry to this learning pathway.

Registrations for Year 7 are called for in term 3 of the year preceding entry. Registering your interest does not guarantee a child's spot in the pathway. Enrolment will be confirmed by the Principal, in writing, after considering the following factors.

Criteria

1. Students must have been enrolled at Kaiti School in the year preceding entry.

2. Because this is an immersion class, students are expected to have been in a Maori Immersion class setting. If there are spaces available, students will be accepted from mainstream classes at Kaiti. A Te Reo Māori language programme will be provided in term 4 to prepare the student.

3. Students who enter the Tū Rangatira Pathway are expected to be independent, self managing and self regulated learners who model the school's values. Students are entering into a digital classroom which require these learner dispositions.

4. Students can register by entering their name at the school office.

5. The final decision on entry will be made at the discretion of the Principal having considered this criteria for entry.
