SOCCER

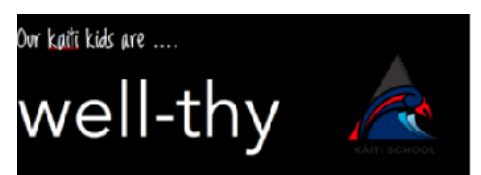
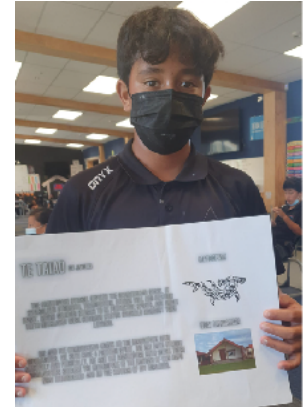
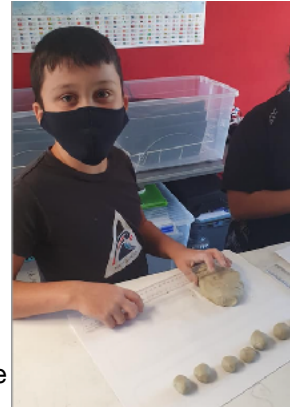
